7. New Business:

- a. Intramural/Intramural All-Star Sports Update (Ms. Patricia Griffin, 734-5607):

1) Intramural Basketball: Season started 10 Dec 07 with 11 teams in the Mon/Wed night league, 11 in the Tue/Thur league and 5 in the 30 and Over league and ran through 13 Feb 08. The top 8 teams from both intramural leagues competed for the base championship. All five of the 30 and Over teams competed in a single elimination tournament. The intramural base champions were The Sho and the runners up were 552 MXS. 3 CCSS were the 30 and Over base champs and Crisp II the runners-up.

2) Intramural Soccer: Season started 24 Mar 08 with 13 teams and is now down to 12. The season is off to a good start even though we've had to cancel 2 nights of play due to weather related conditions. The season will run through 6 May 08 and then will end with a double elimination tournament between the top 8 teams.

3) Intramural bowling: The final night is scheduled for Wednesday, 30 Apr 08. However, because there are 2 teams tied for first, they might have to have a roll off.

4) Varsity Basketball: The men's team was in the North Division of the SW Military Basketball League. Overall, they had a fairly decent season. They finished with an 11-9 record

then competed in end of season tournament at Sheppard. They are now playing at the Transformation Center in Edmond and have 2 weeks of play remaining.

5) Varsity Soccer: The team practices on Tue and Thur from 1700-1900 on the ALS field behind housing area Shoppette. They competed in the Defender's Cup in San Antonio in February and placed 2nd in their group after the 1st round of play.
