

Youth Programs will hold registration for the School Age Summer Camp Program on Monday, May 5 from 3 to 6 p.m. The Summer Camp Program will have 11 sessions running from May 23 through Aug. 11. Every session has a theme that is creatively incorporated into the camp activities, visits and attractions. The specialty programs, tied into each session's theme, keep activities varied and focused from one session to the next. This program is for children and youth who have completed kindergarten through the 6th grade. Registration will be held at the Tinker Youth Center at the following times:

3 to 4 p.m.: **Active Duty Military/DOD Civilians-** Single parents/sponsor assigned to/working at installation. **Active Duty Military/DOD Civilians-** Dual employed parents/sponsor assigned to/working at installation.

4 to 5 p.m.: **Active Duty Military/DOD Civilians-** One parent/sponsor assigned to/working at installation. This also includes one parent/sponsor assigned to/working at installation and one parent/sponsor who is a full-time student. (Full time status is a student enrolled in at least 12 hours.)

5 to 6 p.m.: Active duty members not assigned/working on installation, reservists, and contractors.

Parents/Sponsor must bring the following documentation when registering:

- Copy of sponsor's most recent LES and most recent copy of the spouse's pay stub.
- Check or cash for a non-refundable deposit, equal to 10.00 pr week of care requested (deposits will be prorated back into the weekly fees)
- Current AF 357 or OPNNAV 1740 Family Care Plan if dual or single military
- Copy of Divorce Decree or affidavit, if applicable
- Valid credit card or debit card for payment processing
